The Connecticut Department of Public Health Laboratory located at 395 West Street, Rocky Hill has a summer position available in the Environmental Microbiology Section of the Biological Section. This is a 1st shift position with a schedule of 40 hours per week and will be filled through September 2013. Minimum/starting salary is \$8.25 per hour. Work will involve visiting Local Health departments throughout the state, delivering supplies and picking up samples for processing, specimen accessioning, setting up, analyzing and reporting samples.

Applicants must possess and maintain a valid/unrestricted Motor Vehicle Operator's license. Selected candidate will be required to travel statewide from Rocky Hill.

Preference will be given to the candidate who:

- Has experience with Microbiology or Molecular biology along with college lab coursework
- Has experience with Lab safety procedures, Quality Systems and Standards, and with laboratory computer programs and operations
- Will be available to work through September 2013

Note:

- Incumbent may be exposed to communicable diseases and hazardous substances
- Incumbent may be required to lift standard laboratory equipment, file boxes, coolers and supplies.
