

OVERVIEW:

This live broadcast and webcast is CDC's annual update on the most recent and significant developments in the rapidly changing field of immunization. Topics include influenza, pertussis outbreaks and Tdap, ACIP recommendations for healthcare personnel, pneumococcal conjugate vaccine for immunocompromised adults, vaccine storage and handling, vaccine information statements and vaccine briefs. The 2.5-hour broadcast will occur live from 9:00 to 11:30 am and will be re-broadcast that day from 12:00 noon to 2:30 pm (Eastern Time). Both broadcasts will feature a live question-and-answer session in which participants nationwide can interact with the course instructors via e-mail and fax.
