

Re: Replacement of Main Campus CT Scanner

Dear Ms. Martone:

This letter is to notify the Office of Health Care Access of the William W. Backus Hospital's ("Backus" or the "Hospital") recent acquisition of a Philips Ingenuity 128 slice CT Scanner. The new Ingenuity scanner replaced the Hospital's existing Phillips 64 Channel Brilliance CT System, which was acquired pursuant to Report Numbers 06-30757-WVR/06-30757-MDF. The replacement scanner was acquired at no cost to the Hospital, through a replacement agreement with Philips. The replacement scanner will be located at the Hospital's main campus, 326 Washington Street, Norwich Connecticut.

The Ingenuity scanner arrived to Backus on April 30, 2012, and our go-live date to begin utilizing the scanner for patient care is scheduled for May 14, 2012.

Philips Healthcare took possession of the Philips Brilliance 64 slice CT scanner, serial number 15370, on April 20, 2012. Philips Healthcare disassembled and removed the entire system from the Hospital and returned the system to the Philips Healthcare Factory in Cleveland, Ohio. The de-install process was handled by Philips Healthcare employees and a licensed mover who was contracted and paid for by Philips Healthcare. After removal all components of the system will become property of Philips Healthcare for disposal or other use.
