


The purpose of this communication is to inform the Office of Health Care Access that CenConn Services, Inc.(dba New Britain MRI, limited partnership) will be replacing and relocating one of the two 1.5 Tesla MRI scanners operated at The Hospital of Central Connecticut's New Britain campus.


Currently New Britain MRI operates two 1.5 Tesla MRI scanners at 100 Grand Street in New Britain, Connecticut. New Britain MRI will be replacing the existing Philips Intera scanner, authorized under Docket Number 98-548 and Docket Number 01-1001, with a new 3 Tesla Philips Ingengia MRI scanner which will be located at 201 North Mountain Road in Plainville, Connecticut. The 1.5 Tesla MRI scanner remaining at 100 Grand Street has sufficient capacity to serve the needs of that location.

There will be no change in the patient population served or in the payer mix as both New Britain and Plainville are within The Hospital of Central Connecticut's primary service area.


