





RE: Replacement of a CT scanner at The Hospital of Central Connecticut's New Britain Campus Emergency Room

Dear Ms. Martone:

The Hospital of Central Connecticut has replaced its 32 Slice GE Lightspeed VCT Select CT Scanner with a New GE Lightspeed VCT XTE 64 Slice CT Scanner. The new unit was installed on July 22, 2011 and we saw our first patient on it on July 25, 2011. The unit that was replaced was previously authorized under Docket Number 09-31368-WVR. The new 64 Slice CT Scanner allows for less radiation exposure for patients due to its speed and for superior image quality. The 32 Slice unit that was replaced was relocated to the New Britain Radiology Center on 40 Hart Street in New Britain. It replaces the Toshiba Asteion Super 4 CT scanner which was traded in for removal and disposal by GE Healthcare. Total project costs were \$792,546.36.
