

Dear Deputy Commissioner Davis:

This letter serves as notification to the Office of Health Care Access of Lawrence + Memorial Hospital's replacement of its existing mobile PET-CT and fixed CT scanner with a fixed PET-CT. The Hospital received certificate of need approval for this project on April 16, 2012 (Docket Number 11-31730-CON).

The new fixed PET-CT commenced operations at L+M Diagnostic Imaging Center in Waterford on May 22, 2012. The mobile PET-CT service was discontinued on May 12, 2012 and the equipment was returned to Alliance HealthCare Services, the equipment's provider. The existing fixed CT scanner was disposed of on July 1, 2011. The CT scanner, which L&M had leased, was returned to GE.
