- An information & referral caseworker will help parents/guardians.
- Hours are Monday - Friday, 8 a.m. to 8 p.m., Saturday, 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.

HUSKY Application Center

- Families call **1-877-CT-HUSKY** or call **1-800-656-6684**, to reach a customer service representative in the HUSKY application/eligibility center.
- A parent can apply for HUSKY over the phone.
- After a child is approved for HUSKY, a representative will help parents choose a health plan and primary care provider for the child.
- Parents can also call to check on the status of their application and get eligibility questions answered.
- Hours are Monday through Thursday, 9 a.m. to 8 p.m., Friday, 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Saturday, 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.
