I. MINUTES

B Approval of Hairdressing/Barbering Schools by the Connecticut Office of Higher Education

Jennifer Filippone, Section Chief, Department of Public Health explained that barbering and hairdressing programs starting after July 1, 2013 must be approved by the Connecticut Office of Higher Education. All existing programs must obtain approval by the Office of Higher Education by July 1, 2015.

The role of the Board will be the approval program curriculums and instructors.

III. Office of Licensure Regulation and Compliance
