**II. DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH UPDATES**

A. Investigations Update

Gary Griffin, Department of Public Health, Practitioner Investigations Unit reported that there are 8 chiropractic cases currently under investigation by the Department of Public Health – 3 have been referred to or at volunteer consultants. 3 cases were dismissed.

In addition, 6 cases have been referred to the Department's Office of Licensure Regulation and Compliance for further review.

a. Request for Declaratory Ruling – Bennett E. Siegel, DC

Recommended to Dr. Siegel to contact the DPH regarding whether Massage Therapists or other healthcare providers can perform Body Wraps. The Nutritional component administered topically is directly contradictory to oral use of vitamins per 20-28 (b)(3). We will table the Nutrition and Weight Loss question to the next meeting to discuss with office of the Assistant Attorney General.
