A. Declaratory Ruling Request
Physicals for commercial driver's license

Assistant Attorney General, Kerry Colson was present to provide counsel to the Board.

The Board reviewed a request dated April 30, 2014, from the U.S. Department of Transportation, asking if the scope of practice in Connecticut permits a naturopathic physician to conduct testing and physical examination of body systems to determine whether a driver is physically qualified to drive a commercial motor vehicle in interstate commerce and complete a Medical Examiner's Certificate.

Attorney Colson explained to the Board, the various available options for handling potential declaratory ruling matters.

The Board did not take any action on this request at this time.

The Board would like to receive updated information from the Council on Naturopathic Medical Education as to the current recognized methods of naturopathic practice.
