**I. Minutes – April 13, 2010**

**II. Department Of Public Health Updates**

A. Health Assistance interVention Education Network for Connecticut Health Professionals – (HAVEN)

Maureen Dinnan, Executive Director provided the annual update regarding the Haven Program. There are nine veterinarians currently enrolled in the program. Ms. Dinan stated that outreach to veterinarians in Connecticut has been difficult. HAVEN is in discussion with the Connecticut Veterinary Medical Association regarding the establishment of a hot-line for veterinarians.

B. Investigations Update

Gary Griffin, Investigations Supervisor, Department of Public Health (DPH) reported that there are currently twenty-eight veterinary cases under investigation by the DPH. Five additional cases have been referred to the Department's Legal Office for further review and/or action.

**III. Legal Office Business**

A. Shachine Belle (Unlicensed)– Petition No. 2011-101

David Tilles, Staff Attorney, Department of Public Health presented a Consent Order in the matter of Shachine Belle. Respondent was neither present nor represented. Dr. Cianciolo made a motion, seconded by Dr. Plunkett, to approve the Consent Order which orders Ms. Belle to cease and desist activities that require a license as a veterinarian. The motion passed unanimously. Ms. O'Neill signed the Order.

B. Teresa Love, DVM – Petition No. 2007-200739

David Tilles, Staff Attorney, Department of Public Health presented a Consent Order in the matter of Teresa Love, DVM. Respondent was neither present nor represented. Mr. Young made a motion, seconded by Dr. Cianciolo, to approve the Consent Order which places respondent's license on probation for a period of five years. The motion passed unanimously. Ms. O'Neill signed the Order.
