**II. Department Of Public Health Updates**

**A. Investigations Update**

Gary Griffin, Investigations Supervisor, Department of Public Health (DPH) reported that there are currently 11 veterinary cases under investigation by the DPH. 2 cases have been dismissed since the last meeting. 6 additional cases have been referred to the Department's Office of Licensure Regulation and Compliance for further review and/or action.

**III. Office of Licensure Regulation and Compliance**

**A. Toby Kimm, DVM – Petition No. 2013-723**

Leslie Scoville, Staff Attorney Department of Public Health, presented a Consent Order in this matter. Respondent was present with Attorney John Clifford.

Mr. Bernhard made a motion, seconded by Dr. Plunkett, to adopt the Consent Order. The motion passed unanimously.

Ms. O'Neill signed the Order in which imposes a \$5000.00 civil penalty.

**IV. Regulations**

Hearing Officer Olinda Morales was present to assist the Board. The Board reviewed § 20-196-3 through § 20-196-14 of the regulations of Connecticut State Agencies as they pertain to veterinary treatment facilities. The Board identified changes and additions that may be necessary. There will be further review at future meetings.
