# Our Speaker

William Barry Inman, BA-BS, CIC, is the Epidemiologist for the Brevard County Health Department in Merritt Island, FL. Because of his extensive experience and education, he has assisted the CDC and Quarantine Service with the investigation of outbreaks on cruise ships for legionella, rubella, measles, norovirus and MRSA. He has done communicable disease investigations in long-term care facilities, hospitals, cruise ships, nursing homes and day-care facilities. After Hurricane Katrina, he was part of the CDC team that developed an epidemiology/surveillance program for disaster response. He has published many papers on outbreaks and writes a quarterly article for the local AMA journal. He is the author of the book "Infection Control and Emerging Infectious Diseases".
