These formulas are not hypoallergenic and are not indicated for infants with known or suspected cow's milk allergy

Enfamil Infant	Cow's Milk Based	Most healthy infants who are not exclusively breastfeeding
Enfamil Gentlease	Cow's Milk Based Low lactose Large peptides	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Where some lactose is tolerated and low lactose formula desired. • Like all other cow's milk based formulas, this product should not be provided to anyone with a known or suspected milk allergy. • Like other products containing lactose, this product is contraindicated when a totally lactose free-diet is indicated.
Enfamil ProSobee	Soy Based	Infants with cow's milk protein allergy* or lactose intolerance

*25-50% of infants with cow's milk allergy are prone to develop a soy allergy. Certain high-risk infants should be put on a hypoallergenic formula only (rather than a soy based formula) if they have a cow's milk allergy-the physician will decide this based on the specific infant's medical history.
