NEWS RELEASE

Two Arrested for Armed Robbery at McDonald's

Date of Crime: 04/26/04 at 2325 hours.

Location: McDonald's Restaurant
538 Norwich-New London Tpk.
Uncasville, CT

Arrested: 1) Ferguson, Corey T. 05/03/82 of 11 Idaho St. Oakdale, CT
2) Berry, Kahshan D. 09/25/85 of 11 Idaho St. Oakdale, CT

Charges: Robbery 1st Degree, Larceny 2nd Degree, Larceny 3rd Degree, Kidnapping 1st
with a Firearm, Assault 2nd Degree, Conspiracy to Commit Robbery 1st Degree.

Modus Operandi: On the above date and time, a 911 call was received at Troop E from
the manager of McDonald's, reporting that the store had been robbed by a back male with
a mask and a handgun. The manager was tied up and was struck in the head with the
weapon, causing a minor injury. Minutes before the report, a Montville Police Officer
had stopped Kahshan Berry in a vehicle on Pink Row. After the robbery, Berry admitted
that he had dropped Ferguson off, and Ferguson was armed with a handgun. Troopers
and Montville Officers searched the area. A State Police K-9 was used. Montville
Officers and State Troopers stopped a vehicle leaving the Dunkin Donuts parking lot on
Rt. 32 at a high speed, and found Ferguson in the rear seat, attempting to conceal a
canvass bag of U.S. Currency. Ferguson was arrested without incident.

Detectives from the Eastern District Major Crime Squad charged Ferguson and Berry
with the above crimes. Ferguson was held at Troop E on \$500,000 cash bond. Berry was
held on \$250,000 Cash bond. Both will be presented in court in Norwich on 04/27/04.
