State Police - Hartford Seeking Publics Help in Fatal Motorcycle Incident

The Connecticut State Police in Hartford are seeking the public's help in a fatal motor vehicle accident that occurred on Tuesday evening in East Hartford, CT

At 9:00 pm Tuesday evening, State Police Troopers from Troop "H" in Hartford responded to a SUV vs MOTORCYCLE accident on Route 2 WEST at the merge with I-84 EAST in East Hartford CT. This is the entrance to I-84 and Route 2 from the Founders Bridge. This accident resulted in the death of a thirteen years old female from Hartford who was a passenger on a motorcycle.

The SUV involved in this incident is a White 2000 Mitsubishi Montero Sport. This vehicle was observed driving recklessly along with the motorcycle in the area of the Old State House and the Founders Bridge minutes before the fatal incident occurred,

The State Police are asking anyone who might have observed a White SUV and a red & silver motorcycle on Tuesday evening at approximately 9:00pm in the area of the Old State House or entering the Founders Bridge to contact the Connecticut State Police at Troop "H" in Hartford. 860-534-1000 Extensions #5.
