## HOMICIDE INVESTGATION MANSFIELD, CT

On 08/28/05 at approximately 9 P.M. the Connecticut State Police Troop-C received notification from a family member of an unconscious person at 506 Stafford Rd in Mansfield, CT. Troopers and EMS personnel responded and discovered a female in the single-family residence. EMS personnel examined the victim and pronounced the victim dead at the scene.

State Police Troopers secured the area and the State Police Eastern District Major Crime Squad was assigned to respond to single-family residence. State Police Detectives documented the scene, gathered evidence and initiated a criminal investigation into the death.

The victim was transported to the Office of the Chief State's Medical examiner for a post mortem examination to determine the manner of death. In the afternoon hours of 08/29/05 the cause of death was ruled a homicide.

The female victim has been identified as Anne CARO age 37 of 506 Stafford Road (Rt. 32), Mansfield, CT.

The case remains open and under investigation by detectives from the Eastern District Major Crime Squad and the Troopers and Officers from the Mansfield Resident Trooper's Office.
