On Friday, December 3rd, 2004 @ approx. 0130 hrs. the New London Police Department requested assistance from the Connecticut State Police Canine Unit at the scene of a missing college student from the campus of Mitchell College, located on Montauk Ave. New London.

New London Police and EMS responded to an incident in which several students were involved with reported intoxicating mushrooms. One student suffered cardiac arrest and was transported to a nearby hospital. A second student wandered away from his dorm area into nearby woods, initial search efforts failed to locate this person.

Sgt. Kevin Rodino and TFC ^{Stowell} ~~Stwell~~ Burnham responded and conducted a search with State Police Bloodhound "Kim". This person was located by the bloodhound within a wooded area in an apparent state of intoxication, and subsequently transported to a nearby hospital of treatment.
