DPS-04-060770- KIDNAPPING/ ASSAULT KILLINGLY, CT.

On 12/05/04 at 3:33 PM the Connecticut State Police at Troop D received a 911 call reporting a possible Domestic Violence taking place in a vehicle on River Road near Mason Hill Road Killingly, Ct. Troopers responded finding a 39- year old female victim alleging that she was Kidnapped and physically assaulted.

Investigation revealed that the female was kidnapped by threat of a firearm earlier in the day by her estranged husband in Glocester, RI. She allegedly was physically assaulted and threatened in a secluded area in Rhode Island and then taken into Connecticut.

While in Killingly, Ct. the victim was allegedly physically assaulted again and held against her will with threats made on her life. The victim managed to escape from the vehicle she was in and her estranged husband attempted to run her over with the vehicle. The victim was able to escape and summons help from a passing motorist who called State Police.

The victim was treated and released at Day Kimball Hospital in Putnam, Ct. for her injuries.

The Eastern District Major Crime Squad at Troop D and the Glocester, RI. Police Department are conducting the investigation.
