

State Police Detectives Make Third Robbery ARREST

UPDATE

On 2-22-04 at approximately 11:00 pm, the Connecticut State Police received a report that the People's Choice Mobil was held up. This store is located on Route 188, in the town of Southbury, in close proximity of exit 16 on Interstate 84. It was reported that two white males, armed with what appeared to be a handgun, entered the store, demanded money and left with an undetermined amount of cash. There were no injuries. The suspects fled in a southbound direction on Route 188, towards the exit 16 ramps.

On 02/24/04 the Connecticut State Police Western District Major Crime Squad obtained an arrest warrant issued by Waterbury Superior Court charging **Jason Huchet**, DOB: 04/02/75 with Robbery First Degree, Larceny Fifth Degree and Threatening Second Degree in connection to this armed robbery. On 02/25/04 another arrest warrant was obtained by the State Police, issued by Waterbury Superior Court. This warrant charged **Thomas J. Krasowski**, DOB: 10/31/70, with Robbery First Degree and Larceny Fifth Degree, in addition to Conspiracy on the above charges, in connection to this armed robbery.

On 02/26/04 a third arrest warrant was obtained by the Connecticut State Police Western District Major Crime Squad, issued by Waterbury Superior Court. This warrant charged **Glenn E. Nickerson** DOB: 11/20/78 with Robbery First Degree and Larceny Fifth Degree, in addition to Conspiracy on the above charges, in connection with the armed robbery which occurred on 02/22/04 at the People's Choice Mobil on Route 188 in Southbury, CT. On 02/26/04 at approximately 1130 hours, the Connecticut State Police arrested the accused at his house, 360 Roosevelt Drive #H-7 in Seymour, CT. Several articles of clothing were seized incident to arrest matching the description of clothing used in the robbery. Nickerson was transported to Troop "A" in Southbury where he was processed and held on \$250,000 dollar bond, with a court date of 2-27-04, in Waterbury Superior Court. The media assistance provided in this case was instrumental in the resolution of this investigation, as the broadcasting of the surveillance photos produced witnesses which aided in the identification of the suspects.
