STATE POLICE INVESTIGATING BODY FOUND IN WATER OFF FORT TRUMBULL STATE PARK NEW LONDON, CT

On Friday 01/07/2005 AT 11:06 a.m. New London Police Department received a report of a body in the water on the Thames River side of Fort Trumbull State Park in New London, CT.

The U.S. Coast Guard retrieved the body from the water.

The body is that of a male. No further descriptors available at this time. Identification has not been made.

The **State Police Major Crime Unit** assumed the investigation due to the fact that the body was within the jurisdiction of the State Police.

The body will be taken to the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner for a post mortem examination to determine cause of death.

As of the writing of this news brief this incident is being classified as a suspicious death with no apparent criminal aspect.
