WORLD RENOWNED FORENSIC SCIENTIST DR. HENRY LEE COURT TV PRIMETIME NEW SERIES

Trace Evidence: The Case Files of Dr. Henry Lee debuts on the network June 2 at 10pm. **Court TV—The Investigation Channel**, will premiere a compelling new series, *Trace Evidence: The Case Files of Dr. Henry Lee*TM, bringing to life the fascinating cases from the celebrated forensic scientist Dr. Henry Lee. In each episode, Dr. Henry Lee takes viewers to the scene of the crime, painstakingly recreating the incident and carefully studying each piece of evidence, no matter how minute. Viewers will get a first hand look at how Dr. Lee conducts a series of forensic experiments at the scene and in the lab and find out how and by whom the case was committed. Premiering on Wednesday, June 2, at 10 PM, each one-hour episode features cases in which Lee and his unique experience in crime scene reconstruction played a pivotal role.

In the premiere episode, Dr. Lee travels to Hilo, Hawaii, where a woman's death has been questioned. Her family doubts the story told by the only witness, the victim's husband. With few clues, the crime scene no longer intact, and no body to examine, Dr. Lee used the most telling bit of evidence to determine whether the woman was the victim of a car accident, or murder. Also in the first episode, Dr. Lee arrives at a crime scene where a woman is believed to have been killed by an intruder, but the forensic evidence suggests a different story to Dr. Lee. He is able to piece together what really happened, through clues in the house and on the grounds, and establish a scenario that challenges everyone's preconceived notions.

Dr. Henry Lee, currently Chief Emeritus of the Connecticut State Police Laboratory, Professor of Forensic Science at University of New Haven, CT, is a world-renowned forensic expert. He has over 40 years of experience in several fields of medicine, chemical analysis, physics, biochemistry and material science. He has assisted in the investigation of more than 6,000 homicides and has testified as an expert witness more than 1,000 times in high-profile criminal and civil cases. Dr. Lee has authored or co-authored over 30 books and articles dealing with forensic science and has received numerous medals and awards from law enforcement agencies worldwide. Charming and undeniably passionate about his work, Lee is known for his dedication, his humor and his keen insight. In the series, Dr. Lee's partner is Major Timothy Palmbach, who is the commanding officer of the Connecticut Department of Public Safety Division of Scientific Services.

The premiere showing of commercial free first show will take place at Shangri-Lee Restaurant 965 South Main St. Cheshire on June 2nd starting promptly at 8:30 p.m. The press is invited to attend.
