**\*\*UPDATED\*\* Larceny/Forgery Investigation in Norfolk-Arrest Made**

On 06-23-04 members of the Western District Major Crime Unit obtained an arrest warrant for the above named arrested person, Susan GODDING, charging her with the crimes of larceny and forgery. Based on this active arrest warrant, Tpr. Terra responded to GODDING's residence on 06-24-04 at approximately 0830 hours, where he located her and placed her under arrest for these crimes. GODDING was taken into custody without incident and transported to Troop B in Canaan for processing. She was later released on a \$50,000 bond and is scheduled to appear in Court GA-18, Bantam, on 07-06-04 at 1000 hours.

This arrest was the result of a lengthy investigation conducted by members of the WDMC Unit, which was initiated in March 2004. The arrested, Susan GODDING, allegedly committed the crimes of larceny and forgery while employed by a commercial establishment in the town of Salisbury, at which time she is reported to have taken approximately \$34,000.
