***Connecticut State Police Request Public Assistance in
Investigation of North Stonington Robbery***

The Connecticut State Police, Eastern District Major Crime Detectives, are asking for the public's assistance in their investigation of a robbery, which had taken place at the Fox Trail Lodge in North Stonington on February 8, 2005. Connecticut State Police have released a composite depiction of an individual wanted for questioning relating to this incident; see attached. Connecticut state Police Detectives are also working in conjunction with the Hopkinton, Rhode Island Police Department in assessing whether a suspicious incident in Hopkinton, Rhode Island may be related to the North Stonington, CT robbery incident. SUMMARY OF INCIDENT -

ON 10/27/2004, THE INDIVIDUAL DEPICTED ABOVE WAS DISCOVERED IN THE REAR STORAGE ROOM OF A PROFESSIONAL OFFICE BUILDING ON MAIN STREET IN HOPKINTON, RI. WHEN CONFRONTED BY THE PROPRIETER OF THE BUSINESS, THE SUSPECT INDICATED THAT HE WAS INTERESTED IN THE SERVICES OFFERED AT THE ESTABLISHMENT. THE SUSPECT ASKED THE FEMALE ATTENDANT IF SHE WAS ALONE. POLICE BELIEVE THAT THIS WAS A RUSE AND THAT THE SUSPECT WAS PREPARING TO COMMIT A CRIME WITHIN THE BUSINESS.
