On 09-23-04 at approximately 1145 hours I was patrolling Route 5 northbound in the Hartford area in the vicinity of Exit 87. As I was traveling north, I observed a silver vehicle bearing New Jersey registration RKA71X traveling at a very slow speed in the right emergency break down lane. The vehicle was traveling in an area where if continued to travel another 100 feet would enter onto Interstate 91 northbound in the extreme left lane. I then activated my emergency overhead lights and siren to get the operator to stop before he entered into the left lane around a sharp dangerous curve. The operator then stopped his vehicle in the gore area of the two merging highways.

Upon approach to the vehicle, I observed an elderly male in the driver's seat. I then asked a series of questions to which the operator was unable to answer. He appeared dazed and disoriented and when I asked him for his identification, he could not locate his driver's

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license. He was able to provide a phone number for his nephew whom he resides with. Troop H contacted his nephew, who advised TFC Washington (Troop H desk Officer) that he was reported as a missing person on 09-22-04 at 0913 hours from Pennsylvania State Police. Pennsylvania State Police was contacted and confirmed that he was reported missing.

I then secured Mr. Hand's vehicle on the right shoulder in a safe area and arrangements were met for his nephew to come to Troop H to pick him up and bring him back home. I then transported him back to Troop H where he was fed and remained until his family members arrived to bring him back home.
