Missing Person

The Connecticut State Police- Troop B are currently seeking the public's assistance in locating a missing male from the Sharon area. **Floyd W. Ellis Jr.** (36 Years old) was last seen walking away from his residence at 28 Sharon Station Road, in the town of Sharon, CT. He has not been seen or heard from since 2:00pm, on September 20, 2004.

Ellis suffers from several health problems.

Ellis is described as:

White Male

6' Tall, 255 LBS

Brown Hair, brown eyes and a fair complexion

Last seen wearing:

A grey baseball cap w/ "Ellis E. Construction", Blue Jeans and Tan Boots.

He has a tattoo of a panther on his left forearm

At this time a search is underway, by Troopers from Troop B, in the area of 28 Sharon Station Road, with the assistance of "Trooper 1", the Connecticut State Police Helicopter, and the State Police Canine Unit. Missing Person-UPDATE

The Connecticut State Police were conducting a search of the area of 28 Sharon Station Road, to attempt to locate a missing male, who was last seen walking away from his residence at 28 Sharon Station Road, in the town of Sharon, CT. At approximately 11:30 am, searchers located the body of a white male off of Sharon Station Road, in the vicinity of Webatuck Creek. The physical description of the male appears to match the description of the missing male. The body will be removed to the Office of the Chief State's Medical Examiner for a post mortem examination to both identify the remains and to determine the cause and manner of death. This case is under investigation.
