THREATENING BEHAVIOR

AT

Pomperaug Regional High School

Today 09/28/04 shortly after 8:30 a.m. Pomperaug Regional High School authorities notified State Police Troop-A in Southbury that they had received information of a possible threat that was made by students at the high school.

Southbury Resident Trooper and Troop-A Troopers responded to the school and immediately initiated a criminal investigation. Students and School officials were interviewed about the incident. State Police Major Crime Detectives were also assigned to respond to the school to continue this investigation.

Detectives developed information that 4 students were overheard speaking about types of violence in video games. They were also overheard speaking about that type of violence at the school and the harm it could cause. These threatening discussions took place at school in public and were overheard by other students. The conversation caused alarm to students in the facility and was taken seriously by State Police investigators.

There was no specific threat to any person or to any specific group of people.

State Police Detectives identified the accused in this case. Two accused were taken into custody and transported to Troop-A where they were processed. Both accused will appear at GA #4 Waterbury to answer the criminal charge.

Two juveniles were also taken into custody. They were issued juvenile summons and released to the custody of their parents. Both juveniles will appear in Waterbury Juvenile Court on Monday 10/04/04. Their identities are not being released due to their age.
