

CONNECTICUT STATE POLICE MAKE ARREST Risk of injury to a minor / Custodial interference

On 04-04-2010 at approximately 1200 hrs the Colchester Resident Trooper's Office received a complaint from a resident in Colchester regarding her missing juvenile daughter. The complainant went on to state that she had information that her daughter had fled Connecticut with the accused,

The complainant further reported that she had information which indicated that her daughter was possibly headed to Virginia with the accused.

Detectives from the State Police Major Crime Squad responded to conduct this investigation.

Connecticut State Police Detectives worked with detectives from the Fairfax Virginia County Police Department in locating the accused and the victim. The juvenile victim was returned to her parents.

Connecticut State Police Detectives submitted an arrest warrant affidavit for the arrest of the accused to Superior Court. An arrest warrant was obtained and extradition was authorized.

Fairfax Police took the accused into custody as a fugitive from justice for the State of Connecticut. On 04-21-2010 Connecticut Troopers took custody of the accused and he was returned to Connecticut. The accused was processed at Troop-K in Colchester and held on bond to appear in Superior Court

The accused is being held on \$200,000 Bond. Additional arrests are anticipated in this case.
