**CIRCUMSTANCES OF ARREST:** An extensive investigation by the Eastern District Major Crime Squad, Norwich PD, Groton Town PD and Stonington PD into several Convenience Store Robberies in the Troop-E and Troop-K areas came to an end with the arrest of the accused, JASON Barberi, today at GA10 in New London.

A collaboration by Detectives determined that JASON Barberi and his father Frederick Barberi (dob 12/22/59) had been involved in at least 6 consecutive Robberies beginning Saturday 11/05/11 at the Henny Penny in Stonington then on Sunday 11/06/11 at the Preston Mobil in Preston, Monday 11/07/11 at the BP Gas Station in Franklin, Tuesday 11/08/11 at the 7-11 in Norwich and the Henny Penny in Groton, Wednesday 11/09/11 at the 7-11 in Plainfield and ending on Thursday 11/10/11 at the Cumberland Farms in Baltic.

An arrest warrant for JASON Barberi was issued on 01/13/12. JASON Barberi was incarcerated at Hartford CC after his arrest on 11/11/11 for the Baltic Cumberland Farms Robbery.
