SUSPICIOUS INCIDENT

On Tuesday, January 10, 2005, at approximately 1230 hours, a resident from Mansfield, called the Mansfield Resident Trooper's office to report the he had received an anynomous telephone call at his residence allegeing that had his son, was being held hostage and threatened to harm him if a ransom was not paid Several members of the Mansfield Resident Trooper's office immediately responded to E.O.Smith High School, located at 1235 Storrs Road to check the welfare of the victim. Upon our arrival, the victim was located in class and not harmed. The victim explained that he was unaware of the telephone call made to his residence, but provided the names of several individuals who he thought may have placed the call. As a result of the above investigation, two juveniles were arrested for Conspiracy to Commit Larceny in the First Degree 53a-49 / 53a-122, Breach of Peace 53a-181, and Threatening 53a-62. Both juveniles were given juvenile refferals to juvenile court, located at 81 Columbia Avenue in Willimantic, Connecticut and given a scheduled court date for Tuesday, January 17, 2006.

The names of all parties involved are being withheld as they are juveniles.
