On 07/27/06 The State Police Auto Theft unit arrested the above suspect after a lengthy investigation involving the theft of Subaru vehicle's and their parts from numerous Subaru dealerships in Connecticut, Rhode Island and Massachusetts. Over \$250,000.00 in vehicle's and parts were stolen over a two-year period.

At the time of this arrest a 1995 Subaru Impreza was seized, due to it having a stolen engine and numerous stolen parts. Additionally two Search Warrants were obtained and executed resulting in the seizure of a computer, stolen interiors, headlight assemblies, and other assorted Subaru parts in Windsor and Vernon.

The accused was held on a \$125,000.00 court set cash bond. The Rocky Hill States Attorney's office will be arraigning the accused on 07/28/06 at GA23 121 Elm Street New Haven, due to the multi- jurisdictional make up of this case.

Several more arrests are expected in the very near future.

As a result of this investigation several Subaru dealerships have implemented new security measures to prevent future thefts.
