STATE POLICE and NEW HAVEN POLICE

CONDUCT NARCOTICS RAID AND MAKE TWO ARRESTS

The Connecticut State Police and New Haven Police Department have been conducting an extensive narcotics investigation in the City of New Haven for the past several months. State and Local Police with specialized training have been investigating information they developed regarding a drug factory that was operating on Smith Ave in the city.

This criminal narcotics investigation involved both State Police and New Haven Police detectives. The investigators developed a great deal of investigative information that led them to apply to Superior Court for a search and seizure warrant for an apartment located in an apartment complex at 341 Smith Street in the city.

Today 11/07/05 early this morning, New Haven Police and undercover Detectives from the Connecticut State Police Cooperative Crime Control Task Force conducted a raid at apartment #206 341 Smith St in New Haven.

Upon entry into the apartment investigators located a significant drug factory operation underway. A vast amount of drug operation materials were found in the apartment. These material consisted of: 100 grams of pure heroin, 158 bags of street packaged heroin, \$1,100 cash, several cutting agents, scales, grinders, hundreds of empty bags used to package street sale heroin. In addition this drug factory operation had in place a sophisticated security and camera system installed at the site. This security system allowed the accused the ability to see and observe anyone who entered or approached the apartment where the drug factory was in operation.

Two subjects were taken into custody early this morning as a result of this investigation and search operation:

Possession of Narcotics with intent to sell within 1500 feet of a school
