STATE POLICE INVESTIGATE ASSAULT IN THOMPSON

The Connecticut State Police Major Crime Squad is conducting an investigation of a disturbance, which occurred in the town of Thompson, CT on Wednesday evening September 7, 2005.

On Wednesday 09/07/2005 at approximately 9 P.M. State Police Troop D in Danielson received a 911 call reporting a disturbance that involved several people. The incident was reported to be taking place behind an apartment located at 683 Riverside Drive (Rt. 12) in Thompson CT.

Connecticut State Troopers responded to the location and discovered two victims who had both suffered injury. EMS provided both victims emergency medical care at the scene and one victim was transported to Umass Medical Center and the second victim was transported to Day Kimble Hospital where each is being treated for their injury.

The State Police Major Crime Squad Detectives are conducting this criminal investigation. State Police Detectives processed the crime scene and gathered evidence at that location. Detectives have also interviewed several witnesses in this case.

The identity of both injured is being withheld at this time as the investigation is continuing.
