

DRS Announces *Fast-File*

New Program Will Streamline Tax Filing



What is *Fast-File*?

Fast-File is a convenient and secure way to file your business tax returns over the Internet or by telephone instead of paper.

What are the benefits of *Fast-File*?

- It's fast — a few minutes on the telephone or computer and your return is filed.
- It's accurate — errors are caught immediately.
- It's always accessible — you can file over the Internet or by telephone 24 hours a day.
- New fast payment methods are available.
- It's easy — you choose the best filing method for you.
- You get immediate confirmation of filing.

Which returns can I file through *Fast-File*?

The Connecticut *Fast-File* program will allow taxpayers to electronically file:

- **Form OS-114**, Sales and Use Tax Return
- **Form OS-114**, Business Use Tax Return
- **Form OP-210**, Room Occupancy Tax Return
- **Form CT-WH**, Withholding Tax Payment Form
- **Form CT-941**, Connecticut Quarterly Reconciliation of Withholding

Who can *Fast-File*?

When the *Fast-File* program is fully implemented, most taxpayers will be able to *Fast-File* sales and use tax, business use tax, room occupancy tax, or withholding tax forms.

When will I be able to *Fast-File*?
