## **The Connecticut Pre-Existing Condition Insurance Plan**



The Connecticut Pre-Existing Condition Insurance Plan offers comprehensive health insurance, regardless if you have one or more pre-existing conditions. The Plan covers primary and specialty care, hospital care, and prescription drugs. Radiology, diagnostic imaging and laboratory services are also covered. In order to be eligible, you must:

- Have been uninsured (without health coverage) for at least 6 months
- Have a pre-existing condition such as diabetes, cancer, or asthma
- Be a US citizen or reside here legally
