

It is time for us to review your eligibility for HUSKY Health benefits. We must do this at least once a year. HUSKY Health includes the HUSKY A and HUSKY D Medicaid programs, as well as HUSKY B (Children's Health Insurance Program or "CHIP").

Due to changes in federal law, the income limits for eligibility are higher and we now count your income differently. You will need to answer questions about who lives in your household, your household's income and questions about your federal income tax filing status (if you file); for example, whether you claim anyone as a dependent.

We have different ways for you to complete your redetermination:

- Online option -- the quickest way to complete your renewal is to go to Access Health CT, www.accesshealthct.com. Access Health CT works with the Department of Social Services (DSS) to see if you qualify for HUSKY Health. If you already have an online account with Access Health CT, log-in and select "Create an Application." If you do not already have an online account, go to the website and select "Get Health Coverage."
- Phone option -- you can choose to complete the redetermination over the phone by calling Access Health CT at 1-855-805-4325.
- Mail option – if you cannot complete your HUSKY Health renewal online or by phone, you can use the paper renewal form included with this letter and the enclosed envelope. Please answer all questions, sign and return the form in the return envelope enclosed.

Whether you do the renewal form on-line, by phone or using the paper form, we must receive your renewal by XXXX 20, 2014 or your HUSKY Health coverage will end. If you have questions or need help with your HUSKY Health renewal, please call Access Health CT at 1-855-805-4325.

This paper renewal form may be used only to see if you are still eligible for HUSKY Health. If you are enrolled in other programs that also require a renewal, such as SNAP or cash assistance, a separate renewal form will be mailed to you at the right time. For information about other programs and services provided by DSS, please visit www.ct.gov/dss or www.connect.ct.gov.

Once we receive your renewal, we will tell you if your household is still eligible for HUSKY Health. If you are not eligible for HUSKY Health, you may be eligible for tax credits to help you pay for a health insurance plan offered by Access Health CT.
