




WHY SHOULD I PARTICIPATE IN SAFETY NET SERVICES?

Safety Net Services Can:

- Help you keep a job.
- Help you find housing.
- Help with rent, food and utilities.
- Help find child care.
- Help find transportation.
- Help you at your home.
- Help you learn new skills.
- Help you get services.
- Help you meet your goals.

Safety Net Services Is For You If:

- You are not on cash assistance.
- You are not able to receive cash assistance.
- You have at least one child under age 18 living with you, or under 19 and still a full-time student in a secondary school.
- You have low income or no income.
- You want help finding and keeping a job.
- You want help meeting your goals.

Safety Net Services is:

- Free.
- About your needs.
- In your home.
- Provided by workers in your community.
- Able to help with your rent, heat and food.
- Available when you are home.
