Responsibilities :

Interns will be mentored by professional artists to:

- Develop the ability to depict action and comedy through expressive drawing
- Develop the ability to stage and maintain visual continuity
- Work on character development, provide editorial fixes, and sequence clean-ups
- Gain exposure to the production pipeline and learn how Story interacts with other departments

Qualifications :

We are looking for artists with exceptional drawing skills, demonstrated ability in storytelling, and enthusiasm for collaborating with others. Candidates should be either Junior or Senior level animation students at an accredited college, university or have graduated within the last 9 months.
