This program is administered by the Office of Policy and Management.

DECD's Office of Municipal Development manages many of the STEAP community development projects.

Purpose: The STEAP program funds economic development, community conservation and quality of life projects for towns that are ineligible to receive Urban Act funding.

Eligibility: Localities may receive up to \$500,000 per year if (1) their population is under 30,000, (2) they are not designated as a distressed municipality or a public investment community, and (3) the State Plan of Conservation and Development does not show them as having an urban center.
