2. If significant data withheld process ends.
3. Procedures for security clearances.

POLITICAL LESSONS - 2005

Military Procedures

1. Provide Military Value Questions.
 - Scoring Procedure
 - Definitions
2. Compete Single Mission/Element Bases Separately
 - Only Relevant Questions
 - One Size Does Not Fit All
3. Assure Submariner on BRAC Staff.
