Overview

The Connecticut General Statute section 32-1h requires that the Department of Economic and Community Development (“DECD”) submit a report with information about each new and outstanding active financial assistance project in November of each year. The report includes information such as names, addresses and locations of all recipients of such assistance; business activities; SIC codes; gross revenues for the recipient’s most recent fiscal year; number of employees at the time of application; whether the recipient is a minority or women-owned business; and a summary of the terms and conditions for the assistance, including the type and amount of state financial assistance, job creation or retention requirements, anticipated wage rates, and the amount of investment leveraged by the assistance. The report includes a comparison between the number of jobs to be created, the number of jobs to be retained and the average wage rates for each such category of jobs, as projected in the recipient’s application, versus the actual number of jobs created, the actual number of jobs retained and the average wage rates for each such category. The report also contains projects that were awarded Office of Policy and Management Urban Act grants.

This report is *not* intended to demonstrate the full impact of DECD’s economic and community development investments, initiatives and activities. While job creation and retention is certainly one of the more important goals of the state’s economic development efforts, it is not the only goal. Job creation and retention are not the only measures for gauging the success of an economic development program or project, nor should they be. It is important to realize that the primary reason for doing many economic and community development projects is to achieve other public policy objectives such as brownfield remediation and redevelopment, urban revitalization, infrastructure improvements, job training, cultural/quality of life improvements, promoting economic diversity, and maintaining and expanding the state and local tax base.

This report represents only one of the many facets of economic and community development and should be reviewed in context with what occurred in the Connecticut and national economies during the same period, a brief review of which is also included in this document.

Methodology

It is the agency’s practice to report on the job creation and retention of companies in DECD’s active portfolio. Companies in the portfolio still have contractual obligations with the state, such as the 10-year residency requirement under C.G.S. sec. 32-5a and in many cases, job requirements. Companies are removed from the active portfolio when they have completed their contractual obligations, have had their obligations discharged from bankruptcy or have gone out of business. In some cases there are projects that have on-going contractual obligations (e.g. loan payments) due to the State that go beyond the 10-year period and those are noted in the report.

DECD contracts with a certified public accounting firm to survey active portfolio companies regarding their employment and wage levels. A total of 157 surveys were sent to companies and 128 responses were received. The accounting firm followed-up with companies that did not respond to the original survey deadline by sending faxes and emails, in addition to placing numerous phone calls. It is important to note that the job numbers contained in this report are based on a “snapshot in time” as of June 30th of the current year. The job numbers are provided by the companies and have not been audited, however the accounting firm verified a sample. These numbers do not represent the jobs that will be created or retained over the life of the financial assistance obligation or seasonal fluctuations that may occur. Many of the businesses are in the process of creating jobs and have not reached their contractual timeframe for creating jobs. Other companies may have achieved their required job numbers by the targeted date but have since had a reduction in employment for a variety of economic and financial factors. Final job numbers are not known until the completion of the jobs creation period, which varies from contract to contract.

The report includes data on items such as the recipient, municipality, employment levels, wages, revenues, type of assistance, and fund from which the assistance was provided. The report offers a “snapshot” of those cases, which are currently active, showing their progress since receiving state assistance.

Economic Environment

Connecticut's **total employment** in FY 2003-2004 (**Figure 1**) increased by 3,400 jobs on a seasonally adjusted (SA) basis, from 1,639,000 in July 2003, to 1,642,400 in June 2004. Based on the employment in the 12 months of FY 2003-2004, the projected trend for FY 2004-2005 averages 1,640,300. A comparison to the national index is provided in **Figure 1a**.

Figure 1: Connecticut Total Employment (SA)






Figure 1a: Connecticut vs. US Employment (Index Jan 90 = 1.0)




Connecticut's **manufacturing employment** in FY 2003-2004 declined by 3,700 jobs on a seasonally adjusted (SA) basis, from 198,500 in July 2003, to 194,800 in June 2004. Based on the employment in the 12 months of FY 2003-2004, the projected trend for FY 2004-2005 averages 195,700. (**Figure 2**)

Connecticut's **services-producing employment** in FY 2003-2004 grew by 28,500 jobs on a not seasonally adjusted (NSA) basis, from 1,369,600 in July 2003, to 1,398,100 in June 2004. Unlike the other employment series included here, Bureau of Labor Statistics was unable to estimate seasonally adjusted service employment due to issues related to converting to North American Industry Classification System (this accounts for the more jagged look of the trend line). Based on the employment in the 12 months of FY 2003-2004, the projected trend for FY 2004-2005 averages 1,382,600. (Figure 3)

Productivity, a measure of total state output (Gross State Product or GSP) divided by employment, has continued to increase as GSP per worker increased to \$91,003, which ranked Connecticut first in the U.S.

U.S. inflation, as measured by the rate of change in the **Consumer Price Index (CPI)**, remained rather tame averaging 1.9 percent in 2003. However, it has edged upwards in the recent months to 3.0 percent through September 2004.

The Federal Reserve has increased **interest rates** three times this year. The forecasts for the rest of 2004 and 2005 are mixed as the economy is growing slower than expected, and yet the energy costs and other factors are putting upward pressure on inflation.

State **exports** fell 2.13 percent compared to the 4.40 percent increase of U.S. exports in 2003. Expectations for 2004 and 2005 are for improving performance as the world economies strengthen. Connecticut's exports were \$8.1 billion in 2003.

Wholesale employment increased slightly in FY 2003-2004 to 65,900 (up 1.2%). However, **retail** employment decreased in FY 2003-2004 to 192,800 (down 2.5%). Both sectors have seen sales growth in recent years as 2003 retail sales rose 5.7% over the previous year, and wholesale is up 4.2%.

Recovery from the 2001 recession and prospects for future expansion remain slow and uncertain for both Connecticut and the U.S. The Connecticut **unemployment rate** in August 2004 kept constant at 4.7 percent. However, it was 0.7 point below the national unemployment rate of 5.4 percent. Forecasts for 2005 are for gradual improvement, but market uncertainty due to oil prices and international conflict persist.

The following entities were sources used in providing information on the Economic Environment: U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, Connecticut Department of Labor, the Federal Reserve, and MISER.

Report Statistics

Results

Since 1994, a total of 693 active economic development projects were funded by DECD. Of that total, 177 were projects providing business assistance financing to companies, and 516 were community/infrastructure development projects. Business financing goes directly to companies to do one or more of the following:

- retain a business and its jobs
- help a business to expand and create jobs
- support development and marketing of a new product or technology
- help a business to move to Connecticut, thereby adding Connecticut jobs

The companies that are currently active and responded to DECD's survey have shown a 33% increase in employment since receiving state financing. Recent full-time employment for companies with an active financial assistance agreement is 28,234 as of June 30, 2004, as compared to 21,242 jobs at application. Employment obligations vary from company to company, and may take from two to five years for the company to fulfill them.

Community/Infrastructure financing projects are those which have enhanced or created the infrastructure for development. These include brownfield remediation, physical

infrastructure development, such as industrial parks, as well as funding of organizations providing economic development services at the regional or local level.

Total DECD investment in all projects was \$1,107,243,944 from January 1, 1994 through June 30, 2004. The business financing accounted for \$198,367,345. Of the total business financing, \$121,523,999 (61%) were loans and \$76,843,346 (39%) were grants. Since 1995 the number of grants provided to companies has decreased, as loans became the primary financing incentive.

Community/Infrastructure projects accounted for \$908,876,599, with \$898,367,173 (99%) being grants, \$9,909,426 (2%) being loans, and \$600,000 being loan guarantees. The financing includes funds provided primarily to municipalities, which is in addition to their normal state aid. A total of thirty-eight (38) Community/Infrastructure projects, totaling \$197,607,089, became active assistance agreements during July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004. One of those projects, the Naugatuck Valley Development Corporation Downtown Development – Phase II Project, is a project that has been funded over the last several years. The \$109,508,000 represented under FY'03-04 are those projects that have now been included under one agreement and include costs associated with the construction of the UCONN campus, magnet school construction, and parking garage. Bond Commission approved the first funding under the \$109 million agreement in October of 1999 with the last component being approved by them in May of 2002.

Manufacturing

The majority of the business financing is directed toward manufacturing. Approximately 76% of the businesses financed have been manufacturers. The remaining companies are from various industries such as finance, wholesale distribution, biomedical research, transportation, and other service-oriented businesses.

Employment

Based on the responses to DECD's job survey, employment related to the active business projects that were funded have grown by 33% since time of application. Over 56% of the respondent companies assisted by DECD would be considered small businesses based on having fewer than 100 employees and, of that total, more than 34% have less than 50 employees.

Multiple Financing

Some companies have more than one assistance agreement with DECD. This is primarily due to companies' expanding over time, which prompted requests for additional funds to support their growth.

For example, a company may need to purchase machinery and equipment to support increasing sales, but conventional financing will only provide a certain amount of funds based on their lending criteria. DECD would help to fill that financing gap, as well as

lower the borrowing costs for the company. In the future, this company may come back to DECD with another project to expand its facility, which may require additional gap or low-cost financing.

DECD Pipeline


In fiscal year 2003-04, DECD received Bond Commission funding approval for 10 business and Community/Infrastructure projects that are in the process of becoming active financial assistance agreements. In addition, 48 Office of Policy and Management Urban Act projects were also approved during the same period. Some of the projects may not go forward for a variety of reasons. Contract provisions prove to be onerous to some companies, other companies determine that financial assistance is not a key project ingredient, or there has been a change in the original project and DECD funding is not needed at the time. This still results in job gains for the State, simply without direct financial participation. As the need for direct financial assistance is reduced, DECD focuses on brokering non-financial assistance services such as information on tax credits and abatements, market and economic analysis, and promotion of programs with the Connecticut Development Authority and Connecticut Innovations. In some cases, these services are critical to the overall success of a project. In addition to these services, DECD has been focusing its efforts on making Connecticut's workers and businesses more competitive by supporting industry cluster-based initiatives. DECD also has established its role in more comprehensive community development, which means more involvement in planning, workforce development, and community-related issues.

In addition to projects that had their funding approved, there are 64 community development and infrastructure projects and 10 economic development (primarily business) projects that are in some stage of negotiation for funding or tax credits as of September 2004. The business related projects involved approximately 1,996 created and retained jobs for Connecticut. Some of these pipeline projects have since gone to the State Bond Commission or are continuing negotiations. Others have dropped out of the pipeline only to be replaced by new projects.

DECD Portfolio

Job Audits

Typically, DECD's financial assistance agreements with companies require them to create and/or retain jobs as of a specific date as condition of their financial assistance. Companies that have these requirements may have from two to five years within which to reach the agreed-upon job goals. DECD or an independent public accountant conducts job audits that are required by contract and cover a specific period of time in which the companies are required to have these positions in place. The following information is the status of contractually required job audits that were due as of June 30, 2004.



As noted in the chart, there are several companies that have not met their employment obligation. DECD assistance agreements may require companies to repay all or a portion of their financial assistance and/or have their loan interest rates increase as a result of failing to meet job goals on time. DECD considers requests to modify a company's employment obligation and/or its related penalty when a company fails to reach its target. As part of the review process, DECD evaluates several factors before making any changes to the terms and conditions. They may include, but are not limited to, financial capacity and ability to repay, economic conditions that impact job growth, and market conditions of their industry. In addition, DECD considers the potential impact on the workforce that may occur as a result of penalties being imposed. The status of the 68 audits where job targets were not met, there are 16 that are pending review and resolution, 13 are out of business or discharged through bankruptcy, 10 include on-going job audit requirements, and 29 have been resolved by either implementing penalties or through a modification to the terms and conditions. There are also 3 situations where no penalties were required as part of the original assistance agreement. Modifications may include reduction or modification of financial penalty, reduction of job requirement, extension of time to create/retain jobs, or waive the penalty and job requirement. In situations where modifications are made, DECD typically seeks to obtain additional commitments or requirements from the company, such as additional time commitments to Connecticut beyond the statutory 10-year obligation, additional capital investments, additional job commitments, or alternative penalties. Any contractual revisions are intended to preserve the current workforce.

In addition there are several companies that have multi-year job audit requirements. These companies are required to create/retain jobs over a number of years and job audits are conducted annually with final determination/resolution of their employment obligation coming at a future point as outlined in their assistance agreement.

Recoveries associated with companies that did not meet their job targets total \$5,237,593 and were received from twenty-one companies. These recoveries came from both active and out of business companies and include prepayments of loans, interest rate assessments, and partial repayments of grants.

Inactive Clients

DECD has provided financial assistance to 134 companies that are no longer active and not contained in this report as of June 30, 2004. The status of these clients is as follows:

It is important to note that while not all projects are successful, even ones that fail to live up to their obligations have been able to provide many socio-economic benefits based on the original project investment that was made and the related jobs that were in place during that timeframe. As part of DECD's commitment to continuous improvement, it has undertaken a review and update of policies and procedures related to portfolio monitoring and contract compliance, as well as for new projects.

Conclusion

Sound economic development policy encompasses more than just job creation and job retention. The primary goal of economic development policy must be to build stronger and better communities through sustained economic growth. It is important to realize that the principal reason for doing many economic and community development projects is to achieve other public policy objectives such as brownfield remediation and redevelopment, urban revitalization, infrastructure improvements, job training, cultural/quality of life improvements, promoting economic diversity, maintaining and expanding the state and local tax base, etc. While job creation and retention is certainly one of the more important goals of the state's economic development efforts, it is not the only goal. The other socio-economic benefits derived from DECD development investments and the related taxes generated to fund other State programs should not be overlooked.



We have been engaged by the Department of Economic and Community Development (DECD) to assist in assembling the required information to be reported to the Auditors of Public Accounts, and the joint standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to the DECD, appropriations and capital bonding, pursuant to Connecticut General Statute 32-1h, as amended. The necessary information relates to companies that have obtained financial assistance from DECD.

It was determined that the best method to obtain the required data was to survey companies that had obtained financial assistance since July 1, 1991. Our firm was responsible for controlling the surveys/confirmations requesting that the information be mailed directly to us. We tracked responses and remitted them to DECD for inclusion in their report. The results of this survey are included in Schedules 1-5 of this report. Activities to Assist Small and Minority Businesses

The Department of Economic and Community Development (“DECD”) has a number of initiatives that it has undertaken to assist small businesses and minority owned businesses. Public Act 99-208, as amended, created a micro-loan and loan guarantee program for women and minority owned businesses. DECD committed \$200,000 in support of a loan guarantee program for this initiative, which leveraged \$600,000 in loan funds. An additional \$200,000 has been committed to this program, which will again leverage another \$600,000 in other funds. DECD, working with the Community Economic Development Fund (CEDF), provides a 30% guarantee on loans of up to \$50,000 to eligible woman and minority business owners.

Another program administered by DECD is the Inner City Business Strategy guarantee program. DECD committed \$300,000 in the form of a MAA Loan Guarantee, which will leverage \$1,000,000 in direct financing to be provided by CEDF. Direct loans of \$5,000 to \$250,000 will be made by CEDF to eligible business applicants and these loans will be supported by the 30% loan guarantee provided by DECD. Eligible businesses must be located in one of the five eligible cities, which are Hartford, New Britain, New Haven, Bridgeport and Waterbury. Consideration will be given to eligible loan recipients that conduct business in key Industry Clusters, which will provide opportunities for growth and economic stability in the inner cities. The goal of this Program is to assist entrepreneurs in developing market-based opportunities for inner-city growth that can create jobs, income and wealth for local residents. The Connecticut Inner City Business Strategy, which was launched by the Governor’s Competitiveness Council, supports the types of efforts and opportunities that will be provided through this program.

DECD is also a sponsor of the Connecticut Main Street Program, which is a nationally recognized initiative that is responsible for maintaining and strengthening the physical, economic and cultural characteristics of the state’s traditional and historic downtown urban and village centers. As this program stimulates economic growth in downtowns, it is the small businesses located in these communities that benefit from the improved “main streets”.

In addition, DECD continues to provide financial support to the Connecticut Procurement Technical Assistance Program, which provides marketing and technical services to small businesses who wish to sell to the government (federal, state, or local). The program is staffed with specialists with experience in the government market place.

DECD also provides financial support to a variety of community revolving loan funds including but not limited to the Hartford Economic Development Corporation, Middlesex County Revitalization Commission, Grow Bridgeport Fund, and Metro Hartford Alliance.

It is important to note that all of DECD’s services and financing programs are available to businesses of any size and ownership.

Economic Benefit Criteria

The Department of Economic and Community Development has a variety of economic development tools that it utilizes to support its mission of creating and retaining jobs in Connecticut. As part of its review of projects, the Agency looks at a variety of direct and indirect economic benefits and returns to both the state and a municipality. The Department also utilizes a cost benefit analysis to determine rates of return and revenue that will be generated for the State.

Projects funded by DECD can impact the State's economy in a variety of ways. Therefore the criteria used in evaluating a project can also vary. While each project is reviewed on an individual basis consideration is given to a variety of factors, including the following:

- Project type (expansion, retention, relocation, remediation, etc.) and amount of State assistance being requested.
- How many direct and indirect jobs will be created as a result of the project?
- What types of jobs are being created and will they benefit low and moderate income residents?
- Does the applicant provide well paying jobs, training, and benefits?
- Are the Connecticut jobs to be created and retained commensurate with the amount of financial assistance? Typically DECD provides financing at a range of \$5,000 to \$20,000 per job created and/or retained. This amount can go above or below these ranges depending on the type of project and the capital investment associated with the project. A more capital intensive project may require a higher dollar per job ratio, where as a more service oriented project may require less of a state investment and have a lower dollar per job ratio.
- Does the project involve the reuse of an abandoned building or remediation of a contaminated site?
- What is the current economic environment?
- What type of industry does the applicant operate in? Is it targeted by the State's cluster initiative? Is it a growth industry? Is it an environmentally friendly industry?
- What level of corporate, payroll, and sales tax does the applicant currently pay to Connecticut and what will they pay in the future?
- How will the municipality be impacted in terms of tax revenues and demand for services?
- Is the applicant financially viable and capable of generating the type of economic benefit that they have projected?
- What will the costs be to Connecticut (cost of funds to bond the project, tax abatements, future requests for financial assistance, etc.)?

Other factors are considered including a review of the economic benefits that are generated on both an indirect and direct basis by a project, which can be the determining factor as to whether or not the Department provides financial assistance to an applicant. Social and public policy issues are also considered during the decision making process.

Legislative Initiatives

As the next Legislative Session approaches, the Department of Economic and Community Development (“DECD”) is in the process of considering various proposals that will aid Connecticut's business and housing areas.

It is with the continued efforts of the Rell Administration and the General Assembly that we may build on all the opportunities that arise. As in the past, DECD will continue to support proposals, that will keep Connecticut the best state in which to live, work and play.
