**NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY**

The Department of Economic and Community Development (DECD) is pleased to announce a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) directed to applicants seeking to design and administer a program on behalf of DECD for the purpose of providing affordable housing opportunities in Connecticut. This NOFA is intended to encourage the development of Programs that achieve one or more of the following goals:

1. Create an urban revitalization pilot program that fosters the revitalization and stabilization of one or more urban neighborhoods consistent with PA12-1, §197;
2. Contribute to ending homelessness in Connecticut; and/or
3. Expand the capacity of DECD to provide affordable housing opportunities involving property types that can be more efficiently developed, redeveloped and/or rehabilitated through a third-party administered program than through direct DECD financial assistance.
