### NOTICE OF HEARING

The Office of State Ethics (“OSE”), under the authority and jurisdiction vested in it by General Statutes § 1-99 (b), files this Notice of Hearings alleging that the following client lobbyist violated General Statutes section 1-94, by failing to timely file a lobbyist registration form (ETH-1B) with the Office of State Ethics for the 2011-2012 registration period, and section 1-96 (a) by failing to timely file its quarterly reports (ETH-2D) for 2011 and 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2012, as required by law.

The Office of State Ethics (“OSE”), under the authority and jurisdiction vested in it by General Statutes § 1-88(b), files this Notice of Hearing alleging that the following individuals violated General Statutes section 1-83 (a), by failing to file the 2011 Statement of Financial Interest by May 1, 2012.

- Elizabeth Bayona, Docket No. 2012-02 UP
- Scott Hughes, Docket No. 2012-04UP

If the OSE finds that such violations have occurred, the Citizen’s Ethics Advisory Board may impose a civil penalty of ten dollars for each day that the reports are delinquent, up to ten thousand dollars.

Hearings conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 54, General Statutes, will be held with regard to these matters on **Thursday, June 28, 2012, at 10:00 a.m.**, in the conference room of the Office of State Ethics, second floor, 18-20 Trinity Street, Suite 205, Hartford, Connecticut.
