Statements of Financial Interests (SFIs) – New Requirement

Pursuant to Substitute Senate Bill No. 145 (Public Act 07-___), all required SFI filers must disclose the names of employers from which income in excess of \$1,000 was received during the calendar year 2006. All filers are required by law to provide this additional information by **August 1, 2007**. The Office of State Ethics (OSE) strongly suggests that those required to file do so immediately, so as to be in compliance with the law.

To make this process as easy as possible, the OSE has created a simple Supplemental Statement of Financial Interests form. Individuals may choose to file the Supplemental Statement online at this [link](#), or download a paper copy from the OSE's [Web site](#) and mail or hand deliver it to the OSE as soon as possible but no later than August 1, 2007. Paper copies may also be obtained from the OSE at 18-20 Trinity Street, Suite 205, Hartford, CT.

It is essential that ethics compliance officers and liaisons spread the word of this new requirement so that all personnel affected can comply. Again, the OSE is encouraging immediate filing of this information. While the OSE will reach all required filers via a targeted electronic communication, your supplementary efforts in alerting filers in your agency are of great assistance and we thank you in advance for your timely attention to this notice.
