

MEMORANDUM
Between
THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES
And
CONNECTICUT HEALTH INSURANCE EXCHANGE

THIS MEMORANDUM confirms the following understanding between the State of Connecticut Department of Administrative Services ("DAS") and the Connecticut Health Insurance Exchange dba Access Health CT ("AHCT"), a political subdivision of the State of Connecticut established under Public Act No. 11-53.

DAS allowed AHCT to use approximately 4,150 +/- net usable square feet of office space at 101 East River Drive, East Hartford, CT, (the "licensed premises"), to test the State of Connecticut's technology and workflow solution for complying with the Affordable Care Act (means the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, P. L. 111-148, as amended by the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act, P. L. 111-152.) The licensed premises was situated on the fourth floor of the building and consisted of twenty (20) workstations and six (6) private offices. AHCT was also permitted nonexclusive use of the large conference room on the first floor of the building and access to use the photocopier in the common area on the 4th floor.


1. AHCT used the licensed premises for a period of two months commencing August 1, 2013 through September 30, 2013.
2. AHCT provided its own internet, phones, supplies and support, at its own cost.
3. DAS permitted AHCT to use the licensed premises with the understanding that AHCT would pay DAS Thirteen Thousand One Hundred Forty-One and 67/100 (\$13,141.67) Dollars per month for each full month of use of the licensed premises and reimburse DAS AHCT's pro-rata share of utilities. AHCT's pro-rata share is 2%. AHCT shall also reimburse DAS for any moving costs and telephone related costs not to exceed line usage for three telephone lines.

Once signed by AHCT and DAS, AHCT shall send payment in the amount of \$26,283.34 to DAS for the use of the licensed premises. DAS shall send AHCT an invoice and supporting documentation for AHCT's pro-rata share of expenses as described in paragraph 3 above and AHCT shall promptly pay such invoice.
