### **Trainer**

**Salary \$50.00 per hour**

Access Health CT is the Connecticut state-run health exchange created by the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act to ensure culturally and linguistically appropriate access to consumer assistance and health insurance.

Access Health CT in partnership with the CT Office of the Healthcare Advocate coordinate the Navigator and In-person Assistor Program that will coordinate outreach, education and enrollment activities for uninsured and underinsured residents of Connecticut.

Access Health CT seeks Trainers who will be responsible for training individual grant funded Navigators and Assistors as well as select Train the Trainer organizations. Trainers prepare these individuals to achieve certification status with Access Health CT. Training content meets or exceeds all federally regulated rules and training requirements for Navigators and Assistors.

**This is a full-time, durational position from June 24, 2013 through October 30, 2013. A valid driver's license and a car that the candidate will drive are required. Training locations are located throughout Connecticut. Mileage will be reimbursed at the IRS rate.**

#### **Expectations & Requirements:**

- A Bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year college or university with a focus in organizational development, public health, human resources, or a related field; or five plus years of related experience.
- Have a positive attitude about health care reform.
- Superior classroom facilitation skills with a minimum of 5 years of classroom training experience.
- Experience training through a variety of adult education instructional techniques such as role-playing, computer simulations, group exercises and discussions, videos, and lectures.
- Adept at handling multiple learners and questions while guiding participants through computer simulations, online information and research.
- Proficiency with all Microsoft systems.
- Stamina to train for 2-3 days at a time in one location over a period of 8 weeks.
- Insurance knowledge a plus.
- Bi-lingual in English and another language spoken widely in CT, a plus.

**Additional Requirements:**

- Travel is required throughout Connecticut; trainings are delivered in multiple locations across the state.
- Clean driving record.
- Must be available on June 24 for Phase I of train the trainer sessions, which takes place in Hartford.
- Must be available full time between July and October to train community Navigators and Assistors who will help implement the Affordable Care Act.
