SUBJECT: KENSINGTON HATCHERY OPERATING PROCEDURES

Upon partial completion of the sterilization program at the Kensington Hatchery, the following operating procedures will take effect:

1. New boots and rubber gloves will be issued to each hatcheryman. These are to be marked so that they can be readily identified.
2. The new boots and rubber gloves are to be washed with a suitable sterilant prior to each use.
3. THESE BOOTS AND GLOVES ARE TO BE USED ONLY WHEN WORKING IN STERILIZED PONDS.
4. ALL EQUIPMENT (SUCH AS NETS, PAILS, TUBS, ETC.) USED IN STERILIZED PONDS WILL BE SPECIALLY MARKED AND FOR USE ONLY IN THE STERILIZED PONDS.
5. All equipment will be sterilized prior to use in sterilized ponds.

IT IS VITALLY IMPORTANT THAT THE ABOVE PROCEDURES ARE FOLLOWED TO AVOID REINTRODUCTION OF DISEASES OR PARASITES INTO STERILIZED PONDS.
