PUBLIC UTILITIES REGULATORY AUTHORITY

- A. Chairperson of the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority - To the Chairperson of the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority (“PURA”), and such Chairperson’s successor, I hereby delegate the authority to:
1. Evaluate and approve proposals submitted by an electric distribution company only to build, own or operate one or more generation facilities up to an aggregate of twenty megawatts using Class I renewable energy sources as defined in section 16-1 of the general statutes. Such evaluation and approval shall be exercised consistent with and in conformance with section 127 of Public Act 11-80; and
 2. Conduct an uncontested proceeding to approve, with any amendments those conducting the proceeding determine necessary, a procurement plan submitted by the procurement manager of the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. §§ 16-244m(a) and 16-244m(d). This delegation is limited to the 2012 Procurement Plan and shall expire on October 15, 2012, or upon the approval of the 2012 Procurement Plan by PURA, whichever occurs first. The Chairperson may re-delegate this authority in the manner provided for in Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-2(c).
