Public Censure

In re: The Honorable Harold H. Dean, September 15, 1997.

The Judicial Review Council, having fully heard at a public hearing the charges against the Honorable Harold H. Dean, hereby finds the Honorable Harold H. Dean guilty of failing to observe high standards of conduct so that the integrity of the judiciary may be preserved and, further, finds the Honorable Harold H. Dean guilty of failing to act at all times in a manner that promotes public confidence in the integrity of the judiciary, all in violation of Canon 1 and Canon 2 of the Code of Judicial Conduct, and Section 51-51i of the Connecticut General Statutes.

Therefore, the Judicial Review Council publicly censures the Honorable Harold H. Dean.
