

**Notice to Attorneys re Lead Paint Litigation
Superior Court, Civil Division**

Notice is hereby given that on March 11, 1997 the Honorable Linda K. Lager, Presiding Judge for Lead Paint Litigation (LPL), issued LPL Case Management Order No. 2 which applies to all civil matters in the Superior Court of the State of Connecticut in which a claim of damages resulting from lead paint exposure has been or is made.

Notice is also given that the LPL short calendar form has been revised. The revised form (effective 3/11/97) should be used in lieu of the LPL short calendar form appended to the LPL Case Management Order No. 1.

In re: Honorable Robert C. Flanagan, April 24, 1996.

The Judicial Review Council, having fully heard at a public hearing the charges against the Honorable Robert C. Flanagan, hereby finds the Honorable Robert C. Flanagan guilty of failing to observe high standards of conduct so that the integrity and independence of the judiciary may be preserved in violation of Canon 1 of the Code of Judicial Conduct and further finds the Honorable Robert C. Flanagan guilty of failure to act at all times in a manner that promotes public confidence in the integrity and impartiality of the judiciary in violation of Canon 2A of the Code of Judicial Conduct.

Therefore, the Judicial Review Council publicly censures the Honorable Robert C. Flanagan.
